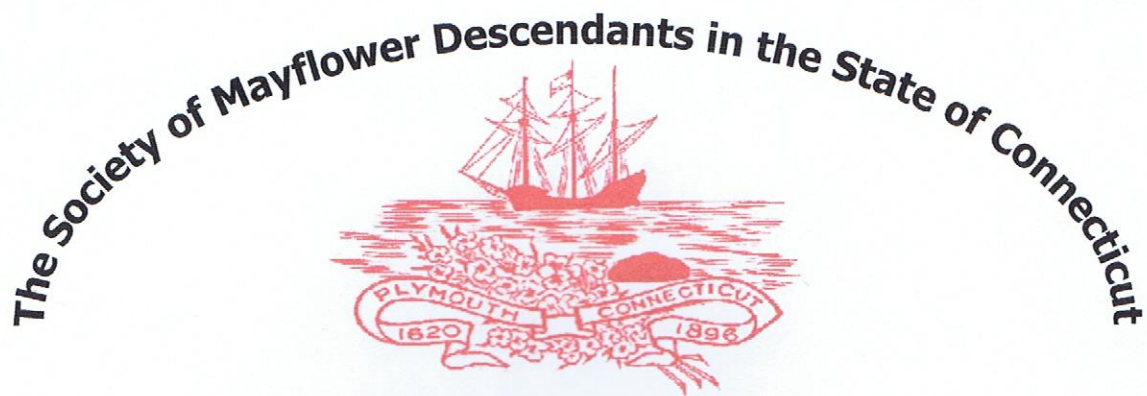


SCHOLARSHIPS PROGRAM

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

1. You must be a resident of the state of Connecticut and a graduating senior of a Connecticut secondary school, public or private or a Junior affiliate member of the Connecticut Mayflower Society.
2. You must have confirmed plans to attend a college or university (copy of letter of acceptance or copy of submitted applications).
3. You must provide all requested documentation.
4. The Chairperson must receive the completed application and all required documentation no later than March 1.
5. Academic achievement, extra-curricular involvement, community service and financial need will be considered in the review of each application.
6. The recipient will be notified in the spring.
7. Evidence of your enrollment at a college or university is a prerequisite to the actual award.

Please note that this year \$1,250 will be awarded for each of three scholarships: the Mrs. Henry Griggs Isham Scholarship, the Bernice Andrews Livingston Rieg Scholarship and the Jordon Konov Scholarship. The monies will be disbursed at the start of the second semester.
